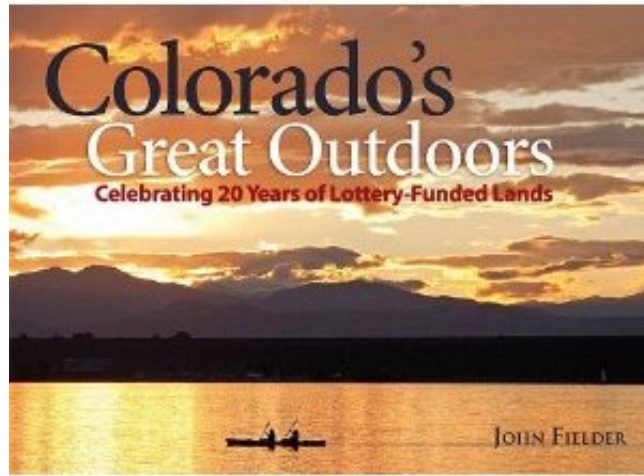

Did You Know?

Beyond the Open Space Tax

Did you know?... 75% of the conservation easements held by the Eagle Valley Land Trust did not use any money from the Eagle County Open Space Tax; only 25% of our successful local land conservation projects utilized open space taxes. Your local Land Trust currently holds 24 conservation easements. Of these 24 projects, 6 included Eagle County Open Space taxes. 18 conservation easements were donated or privately funded without the use of Eagle County taxpayer dollars.

All conservation easements, whether donated or purchased, benefit our entire community by protecting open spaces, scenic views, wildlife habitat, historic lands and waterways for the people of Eagle County... forever.
